CAMP DESCRIPTION

This class is dedicated to having some musical fun and gaining experience playing in a jazz band setting during the summer. Intended for students who play woodwind, brass

or percussion instruments, as well as rhythm section instruments (piano, bass, drums, guitar). Many traditional big band jazz styles will be explored including jazz influence on latin, rock, and pop scene. Camp is for students entering grades 7-12 in fall 2016 with one or more years experience.



Joe Ingram taught music for 34 years, the last 27 as the band director at Shasta Middle School in Eugene. During that time his concert



bands consistently received superior ratings at festivals and his jazz bands at Shasta and Willamette High School won festivals in Oregon, Washington and Idaho. Highlights include first place at the Lionel Hampton jazz festival, the sweepstakes award at the Bellevue Jazz Festival, as well as, winning the High School Combo division with his middle school combo four times at the Pleasant Hill Jazz Festival.

Joe traveled as a staff member to Europe with the Oregon Ambassadors of Music on three occasions and directed many jazz and concert band camps during the summer through Oregon Festival of American Music and ESYO.

In 1993 he was awarded the Presidential Scholars Distinguished Teachers Award in a ceremony at the White House, and in 2005 was selected as one of six Oregon Middle School Teachers of the Year. In 2011 Joe was inducted into the Bandmasters of the Northwest Association and honored as ACE teacher of the year

in the Bethel School District. In 2012 he was recognized as Outstanding Music Educator by the Oregon Music Education Association.

Joe currently teaches jazz band at Cal Young Middle School and is also an adjunct instructor in the music education department at the University of Oregon.

WHAT IS EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD YOUTH ORCHESTRAS?

ESYO's vision is to inspire and lead students on a journey of discovery through orchestral instruction and performance. We do this by offering the highest-quality instruction progressing from beginning classes to advanced orchestras, offering need-based program and private lesson scholarships, and collaborating with area schools and arts organizations.

ESYO's sequential orchestral program includes five levels of orchestral training designed for students from grade four through the age of twenty-one. For grade-schoolers, ESYO has worked in partnership with area schools to maintain crucial first year classes called String Academies. Students may then continue through String Academy 2, for strings only, and three auditioned ensembles: Little Symphony (strings only), Junior Orchestra and the Eugene-Springfield Youth Symphony (both full symphonic orchestras). Other ESYO classes include summer musical theater, jazz bandm ukulele, and rock strings camps.


Attendance Policy: Daily attendance is required. The camp experience is cumulative and campers work together towards their performance.


