Eugene-Springfield Youth Orchestras' (ESYO) mission is to inspire and lead students on a journey of discovery through orchestral instruction and performance. We do this by: a) providing high-quality music education from beginning classes to advanced orchestras, b) offering need-based program and private lesson scholarships, and c) collaborating with schools and arts organizations.

Serving hundreds of families, ESYO is committed to providing access for all, and financial aid to any family that needs it. Our goal is to ensure that all children, regardless of socio-economic background, have the opportunity to be part of ESYO's music programs.

ESYO's programming includes five levels of tiered orchestral training, including strings classes for young children in partnership with the school district. Students advance through several levels of ensemble, culminating in the Eugene-Springfield Youth Symphony, which represents the finest young musicians in the area. *Established in 1934, it is the second-oldest youth orchestra west of the Mississippi!*
